Referral criteria for Regional Burn Unit:

- Burns greater than 10% total body surface area (TBSA) or 5% in a child.
- Burns of special areas, eg. the face, hands, feet, genitalia, perineum and major joints.
- Full thickness burns greater than 5% TBSA.
- Electrical burns (including lightning injury).
- Chemical burns.
- Burn injury with inhalation injury.
- Circumferential burns of the limbs or chest.
- Burns at the extremes of age, ie. young children and the elderly.
- Burn injury in patients with pre-existing medical disorders that could complicate management, prolong recovery, or affect mortality.
- Any patient with burns and concomitant trauma (e.g. fractures) in which the burn injury poses the
